



# Transfers, Stamps Moulds & Inlays

## STAMPS

Start by lightly sanding the surface of the stamp to rough it up and prepare it for paint or ink. Pull the stamp from the plastic sheet and either place on a sheet of flexiplastic or freehand.

## DIY PAINT

DIY Paint works wonderfully with IOD Decor Stamps. When using paint, pour a small puddle on a plate. Using an IOD brayer, roll through to get an even load and roll over stamp. This will take a little practice, use cardboard or scrap paper or wood.

## INK

IOD Decor Ink works fabulously with Decor Stamps. Ink will give a finer detail and is more translucent. Use a blank stamp pad, spread IOD Ink over pad in zig zag motion to load up. Use a brayer to get ink onto stamp or press the ink pad directly onto the stamp.

## SURFACES:

Fabric: Use a well loaded brayer or ink pad. 100% cotton works best as the ink or DIY Paint will penetrate the surface. Heat set with an iron before washing.

## TRANSFERS

Start with a dust free surface. Keep your transfer with its backing in place while you position the transfer. Pull the backing away and gently press transfer into place. Using the plastic burnishing stick, work from one section at a time. When the transfer adheres to your surface, it will be opaque and the plastic backing will release. You can also pull the backing up to see if the transfer is adhered, if there is some left, place it down and finish burnishing it.

Seal with DIY Paint Clear Wax, Liquid Patina, or Big Top

## IOD MOULDS

The IOD Décor Moulds are made from food safe materials (do not use the same set for food and crafts), and can be used to transform and create baked goods, furniture, soaps, jewelry.

Air dry clay, or paper clay: IOD paper clay is an air dry medium. Like most paper pulp based air dry clays, some shrinking, warping, and cracking is inherent. Our favorite way to apply moulded pieces is to remove them from the mould while still moist, and adhere to the surface with the appropriate glue so it conforms well.

Casting resins: If you need to conform them to a curved surface, this can be done if removed from the mould before it's completely hardened. Casting resins are fun for jewelry making and looks great when painted with DIY Paint!

## INLAYS

Inlays are unlike any other product you have tried. They are dry paint you embed into existing wet paint. Inlays can be used up to 3 times with great results. For best results, wet the back of your inlay before placing it in your wet paint. Like a transfer, put it down once and don't move it. Allow to completely dry. Rewet the inlay again with damp rag or paper towel, carefully pull straight up and set aside to dry & use again!

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
